



## **Skyguide and Skycontrol resume dialogue**

**Geneva, 17 July 2018.** Skyguide, Switzerland's air navigation services, and the Skycontrol air traffic controllers' union met today under the auspices of the CRCT (Chambre des relations collectives de travail). The parties agreed to resume dialogue to find a common solution and overcome their dispute. In view of this resumption of dialogue, the strike announced as of 23 July 2018 will not take place.
