

## Robert Stadler named new Head of Engineering & Technical Services

**Geneva, April 21, 2008.** Skyguide has appointed Robert Stadler as the new head of its Engineering & Technical Services division. Stadler also becomes a member of Executive Management at Switzerland's air traffic services company. He will assume his new duties on August 1.
